

VIMANA was presented in Dubai to the Minister of Infrastructure Development of UAE and CEO of The RTA

October 30, 2017 – Dubai – VIMANA Autonomous Aerial Vehicle (<http://vimana.global/>) became a Gold Sponsor of the Arab Future Cities Summit (<http://www.smartcitiesdubai.com/>) which was held on 30-31th October.
